



**CHUKCHANSI POWWOW
VENDOR ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

1. Each space is 10x10. May purchase up to three (3) spaces at full rate for each space.
2. This is a three-day event. Vendor fees are non-refundable, even if you choose to leave early or arrive late.
3. All booth spaces are located on an asphalt surface, you must provide tie down weights on all canopies.
4. Full payment is required to guarantee a vendor space. Location of space is on a first come, first serve basis.
5. All vendors will need to check-in at the registration booth prior to set-up and must provide raffle item (minimum value = \$25). Raffle item cannot be a food credit at your booth. A registration number will not be issued until raffle item is received.
6. Chukchansi tribal member vendor booth space will be available for set-up on Thursday, 10/9 from 12PM – 6PM.
7. All other vendor booth spaces will be available for set-up on Friday, 10/10 starting at 8AM.
8. Booths need to be open and ready to sell by 4PM on Friday and 10AM on Saturday & Sunday. All vehicles must be moved to designated vendor parking area 30 minutes prior to sell time.
9. No parking at booth location. A designated parking lot area near the vendor booths will be available. One (1) Vendor Parking pass will be given to vendors for each booth space purchased.
10. Powwow organizers, tribe, tribal businesses will not provide ice, power, power cords, tables, table clothes, chairs, shade, weights for canopy, sanitizer buckets, fire extinguisher, products, etc. for personal use at your booth.
11. RV/travel trailer and tent dry camping is available and located in designated areas on-site. Yosemite RV Resort, located three (3) miles away from the powwow grounds, is also available. For rates, please call 866-862-4059.
12. There is a hotel room block available, but rooms are limited. Call 866-794-6946 to make a reservation.
13. The following sales will not be permitted: sage, tobacco, alcohol, toy guns, noisemakers, fireworks, silly string, and poppers of any kind.
14. Vendor private raffle items will not be allowed to be announced in the arena and is the sole responsibility of vendor to distribute to their raffle winners.
15. Food vendors will have an Indian Health Service inspection prior to event. Must have a valid California food handler's card printed and available at time of health inspection. A fire extinguisher must be placed in food booth.
16. The following items are prohibited: drugs, marijuana, alcohol, tobacco, firearms, profane language & wild outburst of any kind, and animals with the exception of service animals.
17. We are not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damaged property. Please turn in lost or found items to the Master of Ceremonies or to the registration booth.
18. Chukchansi Gold Resort & Casino security dispatch number is 559-692-5292 for any incident reporting.
19. Please show respect to Mother Earth by placing your trash in the proper receptacle.
20. Powwow organizers have the right to refuse vendor participation at any time, on a case by case basis, without refund.
